

18 Enna on Good Friday

See Sicily's most famous and unforgettable Good Friday procession. Enna is also known for its spectacular panoramic views of the island interior as its one of the highest provinces, not only in Sicily, but in Italy.

19 "Holy Saturday" to Ferla for the "Sciaccariata" (torches by fire) Sat The Holy Night

Depart: NAS II 7:00 pm Marinai 7:15 pm, NAS I 7:30 pm **Return:** 1:00 am

Cost: \$30 (Bring 20 Euro for Food)

Be a part of something really unique in Ferla, a small town located in the Siracusa province. On the night of Holy Saturday, the tradition of "Sciaccariata" which means: "illumination by fire begotten with torches" takes place. This is the night that Madonna is looking for her son Jesus. We will also see the procession of the Madonna and the Resurrected Jesus followed by hundreds of torches that light the street.

Easter in San Biagio Platani & Sant'Angelo Muxaro (Minimum of 30 people by April 11th)

Depart: NAS II 7:00 am, Marinai 7:15 am, NAS I 7:30 am **Return:** 7:00 pm **Cost:** \$60 or 2 for \$100 (lunch included, bring euro for fees)

Visit San Biagio Platani to admire and taste some of the special Easter bread baked in the form of angels, doves, bells and more.

Afterward, head to Sant'Angelo Muxaro, the most important prehistoric archeological center in Sicily for lunch in a typical Sicilian restaurant.



🥦 Vizzini Ricotta Cheese Festival

Vizzini is famous for it's ricotta cheese creation. Two classic Sicilian dishes, cannoli and cassata, both use a sweetened version of ricotta cheese. Agrigento: Valley of the Temples & Bagliesi Winery Wine Tasting

Founded as a Greek colony in the 6th century B.C., Agrigento became one of the leading cities of the Mediterranean world. Situated on the island of Sicily, Agrigento is universally known for the spectacular Valley of Temples and the sacred area of ancient Akragas, one of the most important colonies of the Greek Empire. After the tour, we will visit the Bagliesi Winery for a wine tasting and a light meal.

A Sunday in the Glorious El Fakhar, sun the Rediscovery of Ancient "Villages and Traditions"

The village that the Arabs called "El Fakhar" is known as Ficarra today. The day will be spent discovering the artistic heritage: architectural, cultural and environmental to learn about the ancient history, customs, and traditions of our island.

The tour will start by visiting the Church of the Lodges "Tracking Leopards" (Leopards is an old Baron dynasty. The Leopards are an old baronial dynasty, the famous Italian director Visconti made a famous film set in the 1800s entitled "The Leopard"), Church of the Abbey, the Prison Fortress, Palace-Ficarra Milio, Baronial Palace Busacca and the Laboratory of the Soap. We will have the tour of Olives Monumental.

A local naturalist will accompany us to teach us about the ecology of this environmentally important area. Binoculars will be available for getting a closer look at the birds.
