

Leonidas Falling Stars and Borgo Antico Agriturismo Dinner

Eat a delicious, hearty, and family friendly dinner at the Borgo Antico Agriturismo. Considered to be some of the best food Sicily has to offer. This meal will offer a satisfying variety of dishes. "Leonide Meteor" shower will be taking place during this time, weather permitting, there will be an astronomical telescope and an astrophysicist to explain the reason behind this phenomenon. The Leonids occur when the Earth passes through the debris left by the comet Tempel-Tuttle. The comet takes around 33 years to make one orbit around the Sun. People can view about 20 meteors an hour at the peak of the Leonidas meteor shower.

Palermo Baroque & Shopping

Discover the baroque side of Palermo. Palazzo Mirto, the Churches of San Salvatore and Gesù, and the famous Palace Gangi-Ventimiglia where the movie Gattopardo was filmed. This film won an Oscar for Best Costume Design and a Golden Globe for Best New Actor! After our tour of Palermo is finished you will have plenty of time for shopping.

Geraci Siculo & Gangi




